THE PFORZHEIMER COLLECTION

The following is a list of Garfield-Perry members who have contributed works of their own to the Pforzheimer Collection. The Collection was started in 1941 by Harry Pforzheimer, a G-P member. The idea came to him when he was presented with some material that did not fit into his collection. He determined that the club library would be a suitable place for these items. Since that time 27 members have agreed with Pforzheimer's determination and have contributed works to this Collection.

The members are listed below in the order in which their works appear in the collection. Following their names is a short history of each member's contribution to Garfield-Perry. The history is incomplete. Much of this information comes from "The Garfield - Perry Stamp Club 1890 - 1990 A Brief History".
