In closing, Mr. Astus said the APS would need a collective response (yes or no) by August of this year. If 'yes', we must be well-organized by 1998. Mr. Allen volunteered to serve as a "clearing house" for the responses from the area clubs. In later small group discussion there was agreement that such sponsorship would be under the aegis of "Northwest Ohio Federation of Stamp Clubs" or similar contrived name in order that no one club would seem to be seeking credit for the project.
